## ORDER

Now on this 12th day of June, 1981, this matter comes on for further order, an election having been held pursuant to an Order of this Court in this matter made by this Court on April 3rd, 1981.

The Court finds that on June 2nd, 1981, in accordance with the Order of this Court and after due advertisement and notice of said election, an election was held to determine whether or not the prior Order of this Court incorporating the Sedgewickville Fire Protection District as a political subdivision of the State of Missouri should be approved.

The election having been held and the results thereof certified by the County Clerk to this Court and the Court having canvassed the returns thereof, declares that there were 105 votes cast in favor of the proposition to incorporate the district and authorize a tax not to exceed 30 cents per each \$100.00 assessed valuation and 34 votes cast against the proposition. Further that for the proposition of electing directors of the district, Mary Starkey received 98 votes, Pamela S. James received 106 votes and Gene Loberg received 108 votes.

Having canvassed the ballots and declaring the results of the propositions submitted to the duly qualitifed electors residing in the district and voting thereof, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the decree of incorporation of the Sedgewickville Fire Protection District entered by this Court on April 3, 1981, shall be final and conclusive. It is the further ORDER of this Court that Mary Starkey, having received the third highest number of votes cast for director shall be a director until the first Tuesday in April, 1983, or until her successor is duly elected or appointed and qualified, that Pamela S. James, having received the second highest number of votes cast for director, shall be a director until the first Tuesday in

April, 1986, or until her successor is duly elected or appointed and qualified, and Gene Loberg, having received the highest number of votes cast for director, shall be a director until the first Tuesday in April, 1987, or until his successor is duly elected or appointed and qualitifed.

Further that the said district is authorized to levy a tax of 30 cents per each \$100.00 assessed valuation.

It is the further Order of this Court that the Clerk of this Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the County Clerk of Bollinger County, Missouri, and to the Recorder of Deeds of Bollinger County, Missouri.
