

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing will be held at 7:30 p.m. on August 21, 2023 at Fire Station #1 in Sedgewickville, Missouri, at which citizens may be heard on the property tax rates proposed to be set by the Sedgewickville Fire Protection District, a political subdivision. The tax rates shall be set to produce the revenues which the budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2024, shows to be required from the property tax. Each tax rate is determined by dividing the amount of revenue required by the current assessed valuation. The result is multiplied by 100 so the tax rate will be expressed in cents per \$100 valuation. This will be remaining at the same rate as the current taxes with
